About Lakewood DECA

Lakewood DECA prepares emerging leaders and entrepreneurs in marketing, finance, hospitality and management in high schools and colleges around the globe. Lakewood DECA focuses on a strong hands-on approach to business and career learning experience through both classroom and extracurricular events.

Students participating in a Marketing, Business, Accounting, or Computer Applications class at Lakewood are all eligible to become members of Lakewood DECA.

Dues and Fundraising

In order to make the Lakewood DECA program as accessible to every student as possible, Lakewood DECA is relatively low in terms of economic impact. A \$40 membership fee is required (due by October 20th) to cover both Colorado and International Dues, as well as registration for the District 13 Regional Competition in November of 2020. Fundraising of various types will be available and encouraged to all students in DECA, including but not limited to World's Finest chocolate bar sales, the annual fudge fundraiser, and any other fundraiser the chapter may engage in. All funds will directly benefit the student who raises the funds.

Lakewood High School Letterman Requirements

Lakewood DECA Members,

The purpose of the DECA letterman is for the recognition of Lakewood High School freshman, sophomores, juniors, and seniors who have distinguished themselves in their involvement in Lakewood High School's DECA chapter.

To letter in DECA at Lakewood High School, a student must participate within the DECA chapter and reach the minimum requirements of the chapter letterman requirements.

A minimum of fifty-five (55) points, a 2.5 GPA, good financial standing, and enrollment in a business class is required to letter in DECA. All remaining points will carry over into the next DECA season.

Additionally, students must abide by the Lakewood High School and Jefferson County Code of conduct. Violation of either of these policies or behavior at competitions and meetings deemed inappropriate by an advisor may result in disqualification of lettering and/or expulsion from the DECA program.

All letterman application forms will be due by April 20th, 2021 to the Google form online (QR code and form to be posted), and any questions should be emailed to Wayne Madsen (<u>wmadsen@jeffcoschools.us</u>)
